



Tour of A-bombed survivor trees

2.5-hour tour

4.5km

Fee : 3000 Yen (incl. tax)

This is a walking tour of trees in the City of Hiroshima that survived the atomic bomb blast.

What are A-bombed survivor trees? "A-bombed survivor trees" refer to approximately 160 trees in Hiroshima, all within a roughly 2 km radius of ground zero, registered as trees that budded anew after the A-bomb blast.
